It was established in October 2009, with 14 founding member institutions from 6 Southeast Asian countries.

We believe that a strong regional cooperation, as will be realized through the work of SEAHRN, will enhance and enrich our commitments to human rights education and activism, and will in turn contribute to better promotion and protection of human rights of Southeast Asian peoples.
