The 2023 Annual Regional Lecturer Workshop on Teaching Peace: Developing Knowledge and Skills on Peace and Transformative Peacebuilding

Thailand, 7 - 11 August 2023

ASEAN University Network-Human Rights Education (AUN-HRE) in cooperation with the Research and Education for Peace (REPUSM), Universiti Sains Malaysia, Institute of Human Rights and Peace Studies (IHRP), Mahidol University and Strengthening Human Rights and Peace Research and Education in ASEAN/ Southeast Asia (SHAPE-SEA) with support of the Norwegian Centre for Human Rights at the University of Oslo are pleased to announce the call for applications for the **2023 Annual Lecturer Workshop on Teaching Peace: Developing Knowledge and Skills on Peace and Transformative Peacebuilding.** This workshop aims to develop knowledge and skills of educators for teaching peace and transformative peacebuilding at the undergraduate and graduate level. The workshop will be held onsite in Thailand. Successful applicants would be provided with a travel grant based on reasonable travel costs. The organizers would cover the costs of accommodation and meals for the duration of the workshop.

The objectives are:

- Build and strengthen knowledge on theories and concepts of peace, conflict, violence;
- Establish links between human rights and peace;
- Develop skills for teaching peace as well as methods of assessment and evaluation of students;
- Introduce lecturers to textbooks and other resources for teaching peace;

WORKSHOP MODULES

The workshop shall include the following modules: Theories, concepts and definitions; Understanding conflict; Conflict mapping and analysis with group exercises; Mapping and resolving conflicts; Conflict transformation and peacebuilding; Peacebuilding and gender; Peace and human rights; Reconciliation, Peace and Justice; Peace and development; Peace Processes and Peace education.

At the end of the workshop, participants will be required to develop a basic syllabus / course plan / class outline on a subject related to peace with example exercises and assessments.

WHO CAN APPLY?

The workshop is open to Southeast Asian lecturers or teaching assistants who are

- (1) affiliated with a Southeast Asian University, and
- (2) who are currently teaching, or are planning to teach peace and related subjects in the near future.











SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection process will strive to achieve gender balance and women and members of LGBTIQ communities are encouraged to apply. The selection criteria includes:

- An active teaching record;
- Good English speaking, listening and writing skills;
- Commitment to attend the full duration of the course.

 - Teaching experience on peace, conflict and related areas. (List courses you have taught in the last 5 years (Year___, course title____, the type of course____)
 - If you have no teaching experience, does your institution plan to introduce any peace course(s) or program, please specify.
 - Area of academic interest,
 - Level of English proficiency,
 - Participation in any other programs/workshops on peace and/or related areas in the last 5 years,
- 3. Uploaded an **endorsement letter from your institution/university.** The letter should explain how the applicant's participation in the program fits into the School/Faculty/University priorities and activities. (maximum one page)

Please note that all applications are subject to a competitive selection process.
