ABSTRACT

The abstract should be sent together with the curriculum vitae of the applicant, all in PDF format, no later than 20 June 2019.

The Secretariat will notify the authors whether their papers have been selected for presentation. Final papers should be in English, with a word count of at least 5,000 words.

Footnotes for attribution of authority will be used. The authors of selected papers for presentation are expected to prepare papers as well as visual media for their presentations at the conference. The requirements and instructions regarding the presentations of final papers will be provided after the selection process is over by 24 June 2019.
