# Emerging Research in Human Rights, Peace, and Democracy A One Day International Online Conference 4 November 2022

### **Background**

In the post COVID-19 era of "build back better" the sectors of politics, development and human rights are re-adjusting to a post pandemic reality. In some cases, there is increased vulnerabilities and protracted challenges as a result of the economic fallout from the pandemic. The restriction of rights in the pandemic has not always returned, and many development objectives are not the same. Problem areas are democratic backsliding, increasing militarization, heightening inequalities, increasing marginalization of vulnerable groups, and the rise of authoritarianism and populism. The international hybrid conference on emerging research in politics, development, and human rights aims to provide a platform for scholars, researchers, and graduate students to contribute to knowledge that not only captures our current lived experiences but also points out possible ways forward in making our societies just, peaceful, sustainable, and rights-embracing.

### Full paper submission guidelines

- 1. Papers will be ideally between 2,000-3000 words long (including references).
- 2. Papers will be 1.5 spaced, will use either Times New Roman, Arial, or Calibri 12pt font size, and will have margins of 1" on all sides.
- 3. Please use APA or Harvard citation format.

#### **Conference Format**

The conference will be in a hybrid format, with live paper presentations at Mahidol University, Salaya Campus, and online panels. All sessions will be accessible online.

There is no fee to present your paper at this conference. Due to logistical constraints, the number of papers to be presented will be limited to 30. Priority will be given to graduate students from the co-organizing programs who are required to present papers to fulfill their graduation requirements.

The conference will run for 1 day. Each paper will be allotted 15 minutes each for presentation and discussion.
